ITINERARY:

DAY 1 SINGAPORE – DARWIN

Depart Singapore Changi Airport for your short flight to Darwin in Australia. Upon arrival at Darwin International Airport, transfer to check-in at your hotel. In the evening, we will head over to the **Mindill Beach Sunset Market**, a modern day market in the heart of the tropics. Located on the iconic strip overlooking Mindil Beach, the market features over 300 stalls which features local speciality and food.

DAY 2 DARWIN – ALICE SPRING – KINGS CANYON

Today, hop onto the domestic flight to **Alice Spring**. Collect your compervan and drive towards to **Kings Canyon**, stop at **Tnorala Conservation Reserve** for a view of **Gosse Bluff**, a magnificent crater. Continue your journey along **Mereenie Loop Road** towards **Kings Canyon** in **Watarrka National Park**ers **Rock**, which is home to **Uluru**, one of the great natural wonders of the world.

DAY 3 KINGS CANYON - AYERS ROCK

Embark on a trek to the summit of Kings Canyon and proceed to Uluru-Kata Tjuta National Park, where you can admire the ever-changing colours of Uluru. Spend the rest of the day at leisure to complete your experience at Ayers Rock region.

DAY 4 AYERS ROCK

This morning, watch the rising sun light over Uluru. Later, you may experience the Outback like the Australian pioneers did on camel riding tour around Uluru. This evening, go on the **Sounds of Silence dinner**, which offers the best of the Red Centre and enjoy your dinner under the sparkling outback sky. As the sun sets and darkness falls, listen to the sound of didgeridoo – a wind instrument developed by Indigenous Australians, and join your tour mates for an unforgettable dining experience.

DAY 5 AYERS ROCK - ALICE SPRING - DARWIN (CONNECTING FLIGHT)

This morning, drive back to Alice Spring and catch your flight home.
