DAY 1 LONDON AND MEDIEVAL YORK

At 07:30, meet your Travel Director to begin your journey north to Stratford-upon-Avon, with its wealth of black-and-white, timber-framed houses. Continue to historic York to stroll the narrow lanes including the Shambles and view York Minster, England's largest medieval cathedral.

DAY 2 HADRIAN'S WALL TO EDINBURGH

DAY 3 EDINBURGH SIGHTSEEING
